MyCare Ohio

MyCare Ohio is **just a way Ohio organizes health care** for people who have **both Medicaid and Medicare**.

Instead of juggling two systems, MyCare Ohio helps **coordinate care in one place**.

This does NOT mean Medicaid is ending.

This does NOT mean people lose doctors or medicine overnight.

Who This Affects

This only affects people who:

- Have **Medicaid AND Medicare**
- Live in certain Ohio counties

If someone has **only Medicaid**, **nothing changes for them**.

What Is NOT Changing

- You still have **health coverage**
- You still see **doctors**
- You still get **medicine**
- You are **not losing Medicaid**
- No one is being cut off suddenly
